Welcome to the spectacular 64th season of the Cascade Symphony Orchestra!

It will be full of exciting discoveries, as we will be performing many pieces for the first time. Our repertoire includes beloved classics like Beethoven's Symphony No. 5 and Respighi's *Roman Festivals*, alongside less frequently heard masterpieces such as Kabalevsky's Symphony No. 2 and the *Langsam* movement from Mahler's Symphony No. 3. We'll also present gems like Wagner's Overture to *Rienzi*, Liadov's *Baba Yaga*, Hérold's Overture to *Zampa*, Elgar's Pomp and Circumstance March No. 3, Dvořák's Overture to *Vanda*, and Bernstein's Overture to *West Side Story*.

We're thrilled to showcase an impressive roster of local soloists this season. Cellist Sunnat Ibragimov will perform Lalo's Cello Concerto, while sisters Jacqueline and Katherine Audas will join forces for Brahms' Double Concerto for Violin and Cello. The Northwestern Winds will delight us with Mozart's Sinfonia Concertante. Additionally, two exceptionally talented young pianists, Aaron Jin and Jeffrey Zhao, winners of the 2025 Eastside Piano Competition, will grace our stage at the Opening Night concert.



Our Holiday concert will be a festive treat, featuring brilliant pieces by Johann Strauss, Smetana, Mancini, Sousa, and others. The exquisite soprano Kristin Vogel will present your favorite Christmas carols and popular operatic arias. As part of our Gold Medalist Program, students from local high schools will join our orchestra for the second half of Sunday's concert.

This season's Family concert will feature Francis Poulenc's charming *The Story of Babar*, narrated by Dave Dolacky. In addition, we will finally find out who our next Rising Star will be! In the fall and spring, our musicians will present their Chamber music concerts.

Classical music has the power to bring joy and enrich our humanity. We, the musicians, look forward to sharing this wonderful music with you, our loyal audience. We invite you to join us on this exciting journey, where each evening spent in the company of the world's greatest composers promises to be unforgettable.

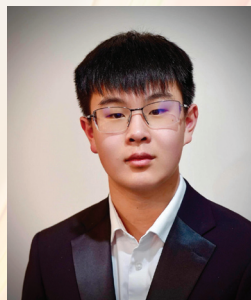

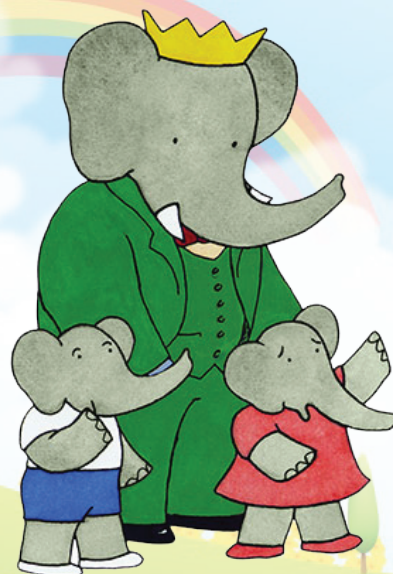
